### Anatomical Position and Planes | Human Anatomy and ...

Used with respect to the midline of the trunk of a body in anatomical position. A structure that medial to another is closer to the midline of the body ' s trunk. A feature that is lateral to another is farther away from the midline of the trunk. Anterior/Posterior—Equivalent to the front and back of a body in anatomical position. A structure that is anterior to another is closer to the front of the body when the body is in anatomical position.

### Anatomical Orientation and Directions | Human Anatomy and ...

When discussing anatomical planes of the body and anatomical directions, we refer to the anatomical position to avoid confusion and prevent mistakes. It ' s assumed the patient is in the anatomical position unless a different position is specified. It looks like this: Upright standing; Facing forward ; Arms at sides ; Feet facing forward

Planes of the Body. Coronal Plane (Frontal Plane) - A vertical plane running from side to side; divides the body or any of its parts into anterior and posterior portions. Sagittal Plane (Lateral Plane) - A vertical plane running from front to back; divides the body or any of its parts into right and left sides.
